	A separate, signed material certification from the manufacturer of the raw material glass, referencing the applicable drawing specification, including glass type and/or melt data.
	A separate, signed material certification from the manufacturer of other materials, such as adhesives and bonding materials, referencing the applicable drawing specification. Include date of manufacture and expiration date for perishable materials.
	A separate, signed certification from the providers of processes (coatings, polishing, etc.) performed, referencing the applicable drawing specification.
	A coating curve report documenting conformance with applicable drawing specification
